## FACTS

### WHAT DOES LANCO FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security Number and Information received from an application</li> <li>• Transactions and Information from a consumer reporting agency</li> <li>• Account History and Payment History</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information, the reasons Lanco Federal Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Lanco Federal Credit Union
What we do	
How does Lanco Federal Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Lanco Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open an account or Apply for a loan</li> <li>• Perform a transaction or Set up direct deposits</li> <li>• Open a new service</li> </ul>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Limited sharing can be requested by either the member or the joint owner.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Lanco Federal Credit Union does not have affiliates</i></li> </ul>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>CUNA Mutual Group</i></li> </ul>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Lanco Federal Credit Union does not employ joint marketing</i></li> </ul>
